Superintendent: Recovery Operations

Key performance areas

- Ensure that the activities in the Recovery section have minimum impact on the environment and health of employees;
- Enforce all set standards/ensure that all subordinates adhere to their personal safety plans;
- Ensure Safe Work Procedures are developed and implemented for all tasks executed;
- Supervise and ensure that subordinates complete their tasks according to set plans; define clear priorities to ensure production continuity;
- Influence and demand service from Support Services to deliver on the required outputs to meet production targets;
- Manage resources (equipment and people) in a safe and efficient way to achieve target;
- Ensure optimum utilisation of plant equipment and people by planning and scheduling to meet production targets on a daily basis;
- Develop and implement Standard Operating Procedures and guidelines in the Recovery section;
- Cost management; and
- Continuous improvement.

Minimum qualifications

- Grade 12 with 20 points;
- A recognised Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Engineering degree in Chemical/Metallurgical/ Mineral processing;
- Minimum five years' working experience in a Processing plant, of which three years should have been in a supervisory position; and
- A Code BE driver's licence.
